Railway Land, owners, were to inspect it 5-9th July, no report yet. 3 emails from parish council, and several from residents, concerning traffic diversions via Draycote from the Straight Mile following an accident had not achieved replies from the police. Highways will repair the Bourton/Draycote lane near the “Draycote” sign.

Overgrown verges- County Highways have a county wide grass cutting plan, but prioritise junctions where vision is impaired. Hedge trimming usually takes place after bird nesting season.
